THE COMMON LECTIONARY

A calendar and table of suggested scripture readings for a three-year cycle, the Common Lectionary provides a systematic approach to the use of Scripture in worship and study.

With each of the three years beginning with the First Sunday of Advent, the Lectionary cycle follows the outline of the Christian year, celebrating the central mystery of our faith — the life, death, and resurrection of Christ Jesus.

LITURGICAL COLORS

The Christian year contains two cycles: the Christmas Cycle (Advent– Christmas–Epiphany) and the Easter Cycle (Lent–Easter–Pentecost). Within each are a preparatory season symbolized by the color purple or blue and a festival season symbolized by white or gold. After each is an ordinary time of growth symbolized by the color green.

Purple is a color of penitence and royalty. St. Paul's uses blue, a color of hope.

White and gold are joyous and festive colors used during the Christmas and Easter Seasons plus festive days and certain other occasions.

Green is a color of growth, used in the Seasons after the Epiphany and after Pentecost, except when certain special days within the call for white or red.

Red, a color of fire, symbolizes the Holy Spirit. It is used when the work of the Holy Spirit is emphasized, such as the Day of Pentecost. It also may be used during Holy Week to symbolize the blood of Christ and at other times when the blood of martyrs is highlighted.
